

English:

This term we will be learning how to write fact files, comic strips and narratives. We will focus on using descriptive language, such as adjectives, adverbs, similes, alliteration and expanded noun phrases to add detail to our writing and make it exciting to read.

Maths:

Our topics in maths this term will be:

- Place value (recognising the value of numbers in 2 digit and 3 digit numbers, ordering and comparing numbers, representing numbers in multiple ways and counting forward and backwards in multiples of 2s, 3s, 5s, 10s, 50s and 100s from a given number)
- Addition
- Subtraction
- Recognising and using the inverse

Science:

In science, we will be learning about the human body. We will discover why our bones, muscles and organs are important as well as the importance of a balanced diet. We will also be learning about light, including how light is reflected, how the eye works and how shadows are created.



Computing:

We will be understanding how to stay safe online, how to download images from online and a device as well as creating animations using a variety of programs.

Art/DT:

In Art, we will be creating superheroes by drawing them and creating models. In DT, we will be creating superhero masks. In addition, we will be creating our own superfoods, looking at product design so we can create own packaging for our new product.

French:

In French, we will cover:

- introductions, greetings and invitations
- names of body parts
- how to count in French to 20
- various French songs and poems

RE:

Our RE topic is How Christians and Muslims see life as journey.

SEAL:

Our SEAL focus this term is 'Going for Goals'.

History:

Our focus this term will be on significant individuals, looking at heroes and heroines.
