Medicines In School

We would like to take this opportunity to remind parent and carers that medication can only be administered to pupils in the following circumstances

- when it is essential and where not to do so would be detrimental to a child's/young person's health: whenever possible medication should be taken at home
- The school will only accept medicines that have been prescribed by a doctor, dentist, nurse prescriber or pharmacist
- Medication must be appropriately labelled and in the original packaging.
- when a parent has completed the relevant documentation with the school office staff
- medication must be delivered to the office, and collected as appropriate, by an adult. Please note that medication cannot be given to children to take home and it is the responsibility of parents or carers to arrange delivery and collection by an appropriate person between the hours of 8.30am and 3.45pm.
