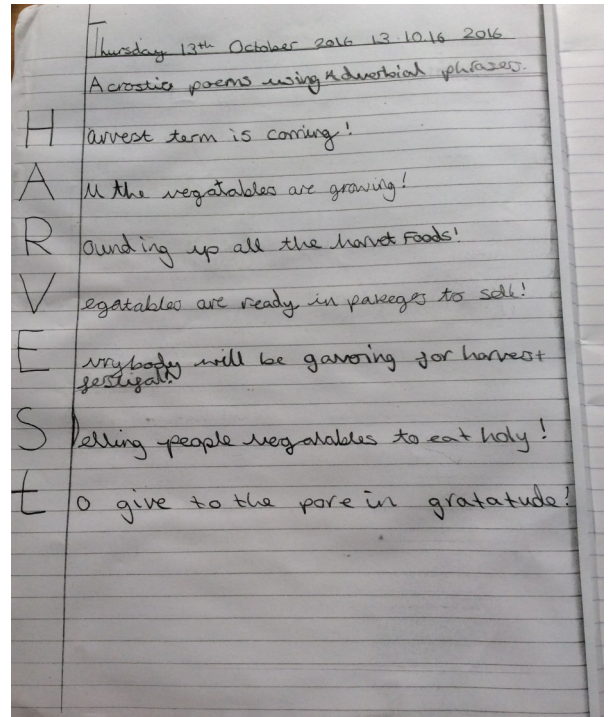

Online applications - you will need to

- * create an account (you will receive a verification registration email)
- * log back into your account to add your school preferences and other details.
- submit your application (you will receive an email acknowledgement to confirm we

Paper applications - if you do not have internet access, you can request a copy of the information for parents and a paper copy of the common application form, contact details overleaf.

The deadline for applying for a school place is no later than 15 January 2017.

P.E Kit

A significant number of children are not bringing PE kit to school. Unless there is a medical reason, all children are expected to take part in all PE activities. Although some PE kit is available in classrooms to borrow, there is insufficient for large numbers of children. Trying to find kit wastes time and has an impact on the education of other pupils. Parents will be notified by teachers if their child fails to bring their kit on any occasion. For children in years 2 - 6, teachers keep a record each time kit is not brought into school. If this happens on three occasions, the child will miss a playtime.

Please ensure that your child brings PE kit on Monday morning and keeps it in school until Friday when it can be taken home for washing if necessary. The kit should include a blue or black shorts, a plain white t-shirt, and plimsolls for indoor PE. For the winter, a pair of black, blue or grey jogging bottoms and sweatshirt, and trainers are recommended.
